

## July 19, 2020 - Parsonage Update:

### Starting with the **Basement Inside:**

There was a sump pump failure a while back. As a result, there are water issues in the basement that need to be resolved. Chairman Leonard has been in contact with Church Mutual, our insurance company. They are able to process a claim for us. As part of the claim process, Scott Wildberg of Master Clean has been here. He will be providing an estimate for us to get it all fixed. We won't be able to do any work in the basement until Master Clean has completed the work for mold eradication, etc. Scott is confident they can do a good job.

### **Basement Outside:**

The outside basement contractors are going to get to us as soon as possible. It is anticipated it will be about a month.

### **First Floor:**

All the carpet is out. The entry way, where the new remodel is to take place, walls have been removed. Vern Neumueller has done a lot of electric work for us. First floor 'destruction' is completed as far as can be done at this point.

### **Second Floor:**

All the carpet is out, waiting to take the pad out. Painting in the three upstairs bedrooms/closets is done. Bathroom fixtures are out.
